Getting started?

These terms are most helpful if you're boat shopping for the first time ever.



Generally, a deck boat has a wide bow for more deck space and maximum seating.



Bowrider

Sometimes called a runabout, bowriders are generally "pointy" at the front and handle choppy water more smoothly than deck boats.



Outboard

Outboards are preferred for saltwater because they're easier to service; the design lets vital engine components sit out of the water.



Sterndrives are recommended for lake boating and watersports, or if you plan to use the boat to raft up with others in coves.


Center or Side Console

The console refers to where your controls are placed; not all center or side console boats are used for fishing, but we think they're the best boats for it in our lineup.

You can skip this if you're familiar, but this is a good primer for anyone new to boating.



Basic activities

These are some of the most common boating activities you'll hear discussed in this guide and beyond. You might already know which ones you're into, or you might not. Figuring it out is part of the journey!

CRUISING

Cruising is perhaps the most popular and easy-to-pursue boating activity. You'll want a boat with good fuel capacity and cushy interior upholstery to support leisurely outings where you can either drop anchor for a swim or go full throttle.

FISHING + OVERNIGHTING

Fishing and overnighting both require patience and enthusiasm. If you're looking to take more focused boat trips that might include angling, look for a boat with either a center/side-console or closed-cockpit layout and rugged, low-maintenance interiors that let you "hose and go" at a moment's notice.

WATERSPORTS

The most common watersports you will see in any given outing are skiing and tubing. For those activities, you'll want a boat with extra horsepower for towing and storage for gear.
